President, Nancy, requests that each Auxiliary allow time <u>prior</u> to the beginning of the next Auxiliary or District meeting to have the following read to those in attendance.

Members,

Based on the number of calls and emails I have received in the last several weeks from numerous Auxiliaries through South Dakota, I feel it necessary to remind <u>every member</u> of the purpose of our great organization. I ask that all members present stand and repeat the Member Obligation at the next Auxiliary and/or District meeting held.

MEMBER OBLIGATION

"In the presence of Almighty God – and the members of this organization here assembled – I (insert name) ______, do of my own free will and accord --, solemnly promise – that I will never wrong or defraud this organization -- not a member thereof – nor permit either to be wronged – if in my power to prevent it.

I will never propose for membership – any person not eligible – according to our Bylaws.

I further state that I believe in God. I will be faithful to the United Stated of America – obedient to the laws – and loyal to the Flag.

Should my membership with this organization cease in any way – I will consider this obligation – as binding outside of the organization – as though I had remained a member – I do so promise." (Members may be seated.)

Remembering that our Member Obligation is the basis of our organization; we periodically should refresh ourselves as to our purpose as members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary:

"We, the members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary have formed ourselves into a permanent organization for the relief of those who fought in defense of our country and those depending upon them, who may need our aid. Each member is expected to respond to any call for relief or assistance of any member of the Auxiliary or any member of the Post who may be in need. We also endeavor to educate in patriotism, the people of our land. You are to be received into this Auxiliary with equal rights of all other members and you are expected to assume equal responsibilities."

In addition, I feel it necessary to repeat the fact the following excerpt from the VFW Auxiliary Enewsletter dated 12/8/15.

"The key to treating people with respect is to treat them as you would like to be treated – commonly known as the Golden Rule. When dealing with difficult members in your local

Auxiliary, seek to understand the root of their problems toward you. Then, you will be able to rise above the situation, and treat them well."

"Treat other people's ideas with due consideration. This means listening to another person's ideas, opinions, and advice with an open mind. Even if you don't necessarily agree with them, give them the benefit of thinking about what they have said.

Be mindful of your words. Words are very powerful and they can be incredibly disrespectful if used improperly. Think carefully about what you're going to say, and to whom, otherwise you might hurt someone.

Cultivate good manners. This is as simple as saying "thank you" and "please" when you're requesting something from another person. It shows that you respect the time and effort that it will take for them to help you, and it will allow them to feel respected."

Please also consider the practice of the "basket exercise" prior to each Auxiliary meeting:

Members should close their eyes, take a minimum of 2 deep breaths to "cleanse" their minds and:

Imagine a basket that is placed at the entrance of the meeting room. The purpose of this basket is for each member to place/leave all bad, disrespectful, petty grievances for any others attending the meeting. These issues are to remain in the basket for the duration of the meeting – NEVER surfacing while discussing the business of the VFW Auxiliary. The member may, if they so wish, retrieve the grievance or pettiness as the end of the meeting. It is highly suggested that those thoughts and feelings remain in the basket and never resurface.

The purpose of our organization is to help others – many Auxiliaries have reached a point where the members are thinking only of themselves and not those we have vowed to assist. Each member is someone who is in need of understanding, assistance and friendship; not to be belittled, forgotten or discarded as unimportant. Let's not destroy our organization from within – member against member for selfish purposes.

Thank you for taking this time to re-evaluate why you are a member in this wonderful organization.

Must be read at the first meeting following receipt before being filed for reference.

- 1. South Dakota Membership is currently at 95.60%, before the March 31st deadline for \$500 to go into the Department Treasury. Thank you all for your hard work. We still have until the middle of June to get to 100% I know the great members of South Dakota can meet this goal, too.
- 2. Congratulations to the SD Veterans of Foreign Wars Youth Scholarship winners:

Voice of Democracy Winner, Austin Lentsch, a senior at Theodore F. Riggs High School received a\$2,000 scholarship (14th place) for his Voice of Democracy entry. Austin plans a career in either biotechnical engineering or international business and he was sponsored by VFW Post 2038 and Auxiliary in Pierre, South Dakota. He also indicated that he has received a nomination to West Point Academy and has been accepted to continue his education at Notre Dame University.

Rachel Rickenbach, a sixth grader from Hot Springs Middle School received \$750 scholarship for 15th place in the Patriots' Pen competition. Rachel was sponsored by VFW Post 1273 and Auxiliary in Rapid City, South Dakota.

- 3. ATTENTION AUXILIARY PROGRAM CHAIRMEN: Year-End Reports from your Auxiliary are due to the Department Chairmen before April 15, 2016. All report forms are included in this mailing. The Department Chairmen are required to have 100% reporting, so please send in or email your report before the deadline. If not received, expect a call from the Department Chairman to take the information over the phone. The Department Chairmen must compile their information from your reports to pass onto National Headquarters. So please be on time.
- 4. South Dakota VFW & Auxiliary State Convention will be held June 9-12, 2016 at The Lodge at Deadwood. Registration form, hotel information, Advertising Form, and Hospitality Night form (for those seeking Department office) are included in this mailing. The VFW Auxiliary National Representative to our Convention will be Jan Owens, current National Secretary/Treasurer and Past National President.

Delegates and Alternates to the Department Convention shall be elected at a regular meeting of the Auxiliary held not less than thirty (30) calendar days prior to the Department Convention. One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each thirty (30) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the VFW Auxiliary at the time of the election of Delegates.

Auxiliary Secretary shall send the names of the Delegates and Alternates to the Department Secretary prior to the Department Convention. Auxiliary Treasurer must send the Delegate Fees to Department Treasurer per included form.

- 5. Please review the Officer & Chairman To Do List in this mailing regarding items needing attention before the Spring District meetings and the Department Convention.
- 6. Ways and Means: Items are needed for the upcoming State Convention Ways and Means table. Chairman, Marion Grant, is looking for baked items along with new and gently used items for this fundraiser. Supplies for the table are running very low.
- 7. **Veterans & Family Support** Chairman, Patti Mitchell, is asking for entries for a Buddy Poppy Hat/Apparel parade during the Department Convention. Get your entries ready!
- 8. VFW & Auxiliary National Convention will be held July 23-28, 2016 in Charlotte NC. Registration, housing and tentative event schedule are available on the National website www.vfwauxiliary.org. The National Convention packets will no longer be mailed. ONLY Convention attendees will receive packets. Do not register unless you plan to attend.

Per Bylaws Section 305 – **National Convention:** Delegates and Alternates to the National Convention shall be elected at the last regular meeting in April. One (1) Delegate and one (1) Alternate for each fifty (50) members or fraction thereof in good standing in the VFW Auxiliary on the date of election of Delegates. The term of office for which Delegates are elected shall be for one (1) year from date of the election, as described in this section, until the election of the new Delegates. The Auxiliary Secretary shall provide the names of the Delegates and Alternates to the National Secretary, along with their membership ID number, within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the election.

- 9. Resolutions to be presented at the National Convention are not yet published. After they are posted, you may view them on the VFW Auxiliary website www.vfwauxiliary.org. They will also be posted on ssdvfw.org under the Auxiliary tab.
- 10. This is the last General Orders mailing of the 2015-2016 VFW Auxiliary year. Thank you to the Paha Sapa (Sturgis) Auxiliary and District #10 for all of your support during my journey to this position. Thank you to all VFW and Auxiliary members for all you do for our South Dakota Veterans. It has been an honor to serve as the South Dakota VFW Auxiliary Department President. You are the best! APPLICATION TO INSTALL OFFICERS

- 1. The Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary President-elect will select the Installing Officer and send the name to the Department Secretary in sufficient tie to permit issuing the necessary warrant. Auxiliary Officers shall be installed in their respective offices not more than 60 days prior to the convening of the Department Convention, but shall not assume their duties until the Department President is installed. (Section 806A).
- 2. The Application to Install Officers shall be sent to the Auxiliary Department Secretary within 3 days of the April meeting (election of officers). The "warrant" is released by the Department Secretary upon receipt of this application provided the offices of VFW Auxiliary President and Treasurer are bonded, the Auxiliary is current in its audits, and item #3 below is adhered to.
- 3. National and Department dues must be paid to the Department Treasurer on a least ten (10) members for the current calendar year.
- 4. The VFW Auxiliary Secretary will read the "warrant" at the time of installation as set out in the Ritual. If for any reason, the installation is not held on the date originally stated, the Department Secretary should be notified as soon as possible.
