Automatic Payment Plan Terms and Conditions: You authorize the VFW to initiate electronic debit entries or affect a charge by any other commercially accepted practice to your account set forth above for the payment of dues reflected on this application. You understand such charges may be made within 2-3 business days of payment due date. For installment payments, charges will be made on or around the 1st or the 15th day of the month. This authorization will remain in full force until VFW has received notification from you of its termination or upon completion of the installment payments. Annual dues are subject to change. By completing this authorization, you acknowledge that you will only receive notice when the payment would differ by more than \$10.00 from the most recent payment. Call VFW Member Service Center at 1-833-VFW-VETS or write to VFW at VFW PO. Box 119028, Kansas City, MO 64171 to inquire about or cancel a payment, or to report problems such as bank closures, lost or stolen account numbers, closed accounts or unauthorized transactions. Cancellation requests must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. Central Time ten business days prior to the scheduled payment date. If you are unaware of the charge date for your account, please contact VFW. If a payment is returned by your financial institution (e.g., due to insufficient funds, incorrect account information, elosed account, etc.) the VFW will contact you at the address we have on file for you, explaining why the payment could not be processed, and providing alternate payment options. The privilege of making payments under this agreement may be revoked by VFW if any item is not paid upon presentation. You may have additional rights and responsibilities under the Electronic Funds Transfer Act.

Life Membership Installment Plan Terms and Conditions: The VFW Life Membership installment plan allows any VFW member/applicant to purchase a Life Membership by making an initial payment of \$45.00 and (11) monthly payments. The member will be issued an Annual membership card at the time of enrollment. The member may elect to receive a monthly statement by mail or may set up a payment profile to make the monthly payment automatically using a credit/debit card or bank account. A payoff amount will be printed on each monthly invoice, allowing the member the option to pay in full. A permanent Life Membership card will be issued upon the completion of payments. The Life Membership fee is determined from the schedule using the applicant's age on December 31 of the year in which the application is submitted.

Delinquencies will be handled as follows: Up to 30 days - continue to bill, 31 to 120 days - delinquency can be corrected through make up payment(s) or plan end date pushed forward, More than 120 days - member is dropped from the Installment Plan, all monthly payments made to date, are applied to future years annual dues.



Membership Categories

Posts in the Department of South Dakota have been divided into six contest categories. These categories will be used to determine points for the All-State Teams for Post Commander and Post Quartermaster. There may be up to **6 White Cover Post Commanders** and **6 White Cover Quartermasters**. If a membership category does not qualify, there will not be White Covers. There may be up to **6** White Cover Post Commanders/Quartermaster who would qualify by the point system in this program. The Top Post in each category would qualify and then **2 At Large White Cover** to the next highest point achieving **Post commanders and Post Quartermasters**.

Also, these categories will be used for other contests that have been introduced or additional contests that could be introduced later by the membership committee.

The membership committee highly recommends you take the time to review "Contest Categories for 2020" and the 2019-2020 VFW National Membership Program. You will be placed in the same category as last year.

To be considered for the selection on the ALL-STATE POST COMMANDERS or QUARTERMASTER TEAM, you must complete the following criteria by the judging date in May of 2020, exact date to be published in April 2020 General Orders. This contest is open to all Post Commanders and Quartermasters in the Department of South Dakota, Veterans of Foreign Wars and begins July 1, 2019.

- 1. All Trustee Audit reports must be reported for each quarter. (June, Sept, Dec and Mar)
- 2. Buddy Poppy purchases equal 5 poppies per member based on your membership on June 30, 2019.
- 3. All obligations for Hospital, S & R and Memorial Park Fund must be paid using Post Membership as of June 30, 2019.
- Must obligate an amount of your choice to the Veterans and Military Support Programs. Send funds **Directly** to National Headquarters VMS Department and send a copy of your check to State Headquarters. **Do not send money to State Headquarters**.
- 5. Post must appoint a Post Veterans Service Officer.
- 6. Post must be **100%** membership to qualify.
- 7. Post must accomplish **one** membership roundup/activity and provide an "afteraction" report to the District Membership Captain by **January 1, 2020.**
- 8. Post Membership Plan **MUST** be submitted to State Office and Membership Captain NLT October 31, 2019. To receive a 100 point bonus, the Post Membership plan with an appointed Post Membership Captain must be submitted by **July 31, 2019**.
- 9. Post must have a 2019-2020 Election Report on file at the Department Headquarters by May 15, 2019.

"YOU'RE NEVER ALONE" 2019 – 2020

A point system has been devised for each of the following divisions. There will be to 6 White Cover Post Commanders and 6 White Cover Quartermasters. If a membership category does not qualify, there will not be White Covers. There will be up to 8 White Cover Post Commanders and Post Quartermasters, who would qualify by the point system in this program. The Top Post in each category would qualify, and then the next 2 highest point achieving Post Commanders and Quartermasters. The Commander receiving the most points will be awarded the **BAKER-SIMPSON AWARD** and the Quartermaster receiving the most points will be awarded the **WILLIAM J RADIGAN AWARD**.

Community Service Reports, Hospital Reports and Military & Veterans Support Reports may be sent in by three month periods. Five (5) points will be awarded for each period of 3 months that the report is received regardless of date received. However, 25 bonus points will be awarded for report received during the month following the end of each reporting period. The final report must be received prior to May judging date, exact date to be published in the April General Orders.

(Receive one Bonus point per quarter if the audit report is reported with 60 days of the audit ending date.)

- 3. August, September & October
- 4. February, March & April

Bonus Points: Each Post Commander or Designated Line Officer or Quartermaster who attends any of the meetings listed above will receive 50 points per meeting. Also, 5 points will be awarded for each post for each member up to ten who attends any of the meetings listed above. The Commander and/or Quartermaster must attend the meeting before any bonus points are awarded.

Maximum Total Points: 700 (22.6%)

NOTE: If you already own an All State cover for this position you will receive the All State and year pin, to place on your current cover instead of receiving a new cap. This will allow the next Commander in line to receive his/her first cover.

To be considered for the selection on the ALL-STATE DISTRICT COMMANDER'S TEAM, you must complete the following criteria by the judging date in May of 2020 to be set. This contest is open to all District Commanders in the Department of South Dakota, Veterans of Foreign Wars and begins July 1, 2019.

- 1. 98.5% in membership by judging date.
- 2. Every Post in your District must purchase a minimum of 100 Buddy Poppies during the current year.
- 3. Inspections of each Post must be completed and turned into the Department Office who will forward to the Department Inspector.
- 4. One VOD entry must advance to the Department Judging.
- 5. Patriots' Pen with one entry advanced to the Department Judging.
- 6. National Citizenship Education Teacher's Awards with one entry advanced to Department Judging.
- 7. Must conduct a school of Instruction at one meeting minimum. (A program or contest and can be presented by a District or State Chairman or State Officer.)
- 8. Must attend the Fall Council and your District meetings exceptions will only be granted by the State Commander.
- 9. District Membership Plan with an appointed District Membership Captain must be submitted to State Office and/or Membership Chairman NLT October 31.
- 10. Provide a District Membership Captain's roundup/activity report to all Council of Administration meetings as part of District Commander's Book of Reports.

A point system has been devised for each of the following categories. For example: The District with the best percentage of membership and new/reinstate will receive 230 points; the second-best percentage of membership will receive 220 points; the third place will receive 210 points; fourth place will receive 200 points; and fifth place will receive 190 points. New and reinstate points will be the same as above for the best percentage of membership. Points in all other categories will be determined by the percentage of posts who participate in the program within the district. The Top Two Qualifying District Commanders receiving the most points will qualify for the All-State District Commander Team and Commander receiving the most points will be the TEAM CAPTAIN and will be awarded the TICE-GALLAGHER AWARD. All-State Commanders will receive the following awards and prizes.

- 1. All-State Hat.
- 2. Registration to the Department Convention.
- 3. Room for 3 nights at the Department Convention (\$45/night IAW SOP)
- 4. *Mileage to and from the Convention from your home (*(\$0.30/per mile; google maps)
- 5. Gift (to be determined)

- 7. Double Eagle Award presented at the discretion of Department Commander

VFW Department of South Dakota Membership Campaign 2018 – 2019



The membership campaign will start on July 1, 2019 and end on May 4, 2020. This will allow time to process each winner for awards. Then continue on till June 29, 2020.

Who May Participate: Campaign is open to all VFW and Auxiliary members. Any VFW member or Auxiliary member that recruits or reinstates one of more VFW members for the South Dakota VFW will receive a beautiful distinctive South Dakota "You're Never Alone" Recruiter pin. A recruiter must recruit members <u>only</u> for South Dakota.

Recruiting from Another State: If a recruiter should by chance entice a member from another state to transfer his or her membership to a SD VFW Post, this member will be considered the same as a newly recruited member and the recruiter will be eligible for a South Dakota You're Never Alone "Recruiter" pin.

How Many Pins May I Receive: A recruiter may only receive 1 (ONE) South Dakota "You're Never Alone" recruiter pin, regardless of how many new members that he or she may recruit. It is common knowledge that the monthly National membership roster will have errors and the recruiters might not get credit for a new member and be included on the roster. This is often not the fault of the Post QM that sent the information into National. Therefore, each Post QM is asked to keep in close contact with the State Membership Chairman who will be receiving the National roster on a weekly/monthly basis. In case a recruiter's name does not appear on the National roster, a statement by the Post QM that a member did in fact recruit or reinstate a new member will be accepted so that a South Dakota "You're Never Alone" pin may be awarded to that recruiter.

All District/Post Commander and Quartermasters who reach 100% plus one in membership by June 10 will be awarded the "Q" pin award.


The award will be presented by the State Commander or be a delegated representative of the Department as soon as the District or Post Quota has been reached or at another appropriate time.
