To be a Quota Buster Post in the state it has been determined by the Department Membership Committee that it will be one plus their post membership as of June 30, 2018 for the year 2019.

Membership Categories

Posts in the Department of South Dakota have been divided into six contest categories. These categories will be used to determine points for the All-State Teams for Post Commander and Post Quartermaster. There may be up to **7** White Cover Post Commanders and **7** White Cover Quartermasters. If a membership category does not qualify, there will not be White Covers. There may be up to **7** White Cover Post Commanders/Quartermaster who would qualify by the point system in this program. The Top Post in each category would qualify and then the next highest point achieving post commander and quartermaster.

Also, these categories will be used for other contests that have been introduced or additional contests that could be introduced later by the membership committee.

The membership committee highly recommends you take the time to review "Contest Categories for 2019" and the 2018-2019 VFW National Membership Program. You will be placed in the same category as last year.

ALL- STATE POST COMMANDERS AND QUARTERMASTERS TEAM AND

BAKER-SIMPSON AND WILLIAM J. RADIGAN AWARD

To be considered for the selection on the ALL-STATE POST COMMANDERS or QUARTERMASTER TEAM, you must complete the following criteria by the judging date in May of 2019, exact date to be published in April 2019 General Orders. This contest is open to all Post Commanders and Quartermasters in the Department of South Dakota, Veterans of Foreign Wars and begins July 1, 2018.

- 1. All Trustee Audit reports must be reported for each quarter. (June, Sept, Dec and Mar)
- 2. Buddy Poppy purchases equal 5 poppies per member based on your membership on June 30, 2018 with a minimum order of 100 Poppies.
- 3. All obligations for Hospital, S & R and Memorial Park Fund must be paid using Post Membership as of June 30, 2018.
- 4. Must obligate an amount of your choice to the Military & Veterans Support Program. Send funds to National Headquarters NMS Department and send a copy of your check to State Headquarters. **Do not send money to State Headquarters**.
- 5. Post must appoint a Post Veterans Service Officer.
- 6. Post must be 100% membership to qualify.
- 7. Post must accomplish **one** membership roundup/activity and provide an "afteraction" report to the District Membership Captain by **January 1, 2019.**
- 8. Post Membership Plan **MUST** be submitted to State Office and Membership Captain NLT October 31, 2018. To receive a 100 point bonus, the Post Membership plan with an appointed Post Membership Captain must be submitted by **July 31, 2018**.
- 9. Post must have a 2019-2020 Election Report on file at the Department Headquarters by May 15, 2019.

"Providing Top Cover" 2018 – 2019

A point system has been devised for each of the following divisions. There may be up to 7 White Cover Post Commanders and 7 White Cover Quartermasters. If a membership category does not qualify, there will not be White Covers. There may be up to 7 White Cover Post Commanders/Quartermaster who would qualify by the point system in this program. The Top Post in each category would qualify and then the next highest point achieving post commander and quartermaster. The Commander receiving the most points will be awarded the **BAKER-SIMPSON AWARD** and the Quartermaster receiving the most points will be awarded the **WILLIAM J RADIGAN AWARD**.

All-State Commanders and Quartermasters will receive the following awards and prizes:

- 8. William J Radigan Award (Eagle Award) to Outstanding Quartermaster
- 9. Double Eagle Award presented at the discretion of the Department Commander
- 10. Captain Pin

- 4. New and Reinstate Percentage in the "green": 5% = 10 points, 10% = 20 points, 15% = 30 points, 20% = 40 points, 30% = 50 points, 50% = 100 points and 100% = 200 points. You can receive five extra points per member over quota up to fifty points.
- 5. Post Membership Plan must be received by July 31, 2018 for 100 bonus points.
- 6. Post Membership Plan must be received by December 31 for 200 points, 15 points if after January 1.

(If a Post is unable to garner support for VOD, Patriots Pen or one Teacher of Year submission, a donation in lieu of participation of \$50.00, for each program, will satisfy the program participation requirement. All other donations will be made to Department Headquarters.) The deadline for donations to count for VOD/Patriot's Pen and Teacher of the Year is post marked by 31 December 2018. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Special Bonus: If your Post participates in the Community Service Program Book Project you will receive **double** the points on every project you complete in the **VFW Programs and Projects Division**.

VFW DONATIONS DIVISION:

You must donate the required amount of funds for your membership category to receive the points in each category. **Donation period is from May 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019**.

Donations must be <u>sent to National Headquarters</u> for Military & Veterans Support and UNMET NEEDS (make sure to send a copy of the Post check to State Headquarters). Donations for State Fair, National Home for Children, Special Olympics and Disabled Veteran Pheasant Hunt should be sent to State Headquarters to receive credit.

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VFW Reporting Division:

Community Service Reports, Hospital Reports and Military & Veterans Support Reports may be sent in by three month periods. Five (5) points will be awarded for each period of 3 months that the report is received regardless of date received. However, 25 bonus points will be awarded for report received during the month following the end of each reporting period. The final report must be received prior to May judging date, exact date to be published in the April General Orders.

(Receive one Bonus point per quarter if the audit report is reported with 60 days of the audit ending date.)

Bonus Points: Each Post Commander or Designated Line Officer or Quartermaster who attends any of the meetings listed above will receive 50 points per meeting. Also, 5 points will be awarded for each post for each member up to ten who attends any of the meetings listed above. The Commander and/or Quartermaster must attend the meeting before any bonus points are awarded.

Maximum Total Points: 600 (22.6%)

NOTE: If you already own an All State cover for this position you will receive the All State and year pin, to place on your current cover instead of receiving a new cap. This will allow the next Commander in line to receive his/her first cover.

ALL-STATE DISTRICT COMMANDERS TEAM AND TICE-GALLAGHER AWARD

To be considered for the selection on the ALL-STATE DISTRICT COMMANDER'S TEAM, you must complete the following criteria by the judging date in May of 2019 to be set. This contest is open to all District Commanders in the Department of South Dakota, Veterans of Foreign Wars and begins July 1, 2018.

- 1. **98.5%** in membership by judging date.
- 2. Every Post in your District must purchase a minimum of 100 Buddy Poppies during the current year.
- 3. Inspections of each Post must be completed and turned into the Department Office who will forward to the Department Inspector.
- 4. One VOD entry **must advance** to the Department Judging.
- 5. Patriots' Pen with one entry advanced to the Department Judging.
- 6. National Citizenship Education Teacher's Awards with **one entry advanced** to Department Judging.
- 7. Must conduct a school of Instruction at one meeting minimum. (A program or contest and can be presented by a District or State Chairman or State Officer.)
- 8. Must attend the Fall Council and your District meetings exceptions will only be granted by the State Commander.
- 9. District Membership Plan with an appointed District Membership Captain must be submitted to State Office and/or Membership Chairman NLT October 31.
- 10. Provide a District Membership Captain's roundup/activity report to all Council of Administration meetings as part of District Commander's Book of Reports.

A point system has been devised for each of the following categories. For example: The District with the best percentage of membership and new/reinstate will receive 230 points; the second-best percentage of membership will receive 220 points; the third place will receive 210 points; fourth place will receive 200 points; and fifth place will receive 190 points. New and reinstate points will be the same as above for the best percentage of membership. Points in all other categories will be determined by the percentage of posts who participate in the program within the district. The Top Two Qualifying District Commanders receiving the most points will qualify for the All-State District Commander Team and Commander receiving the most points will be the TEAM CAPTAIN and will be awarded the TICE-GALLAGHER AWARD.

Notice: Membership turn-in on the day of judging before judging time is scheduled with proper verification (copy of applications or renewal notices and copy of payment CHECK) is provided; they will be included in the membership totals. Also, all other reports or documents will be accepted before judging time is scheduled for other parts of the contest. This is for all contests and awards for Post Commanders, Post Quartermasters & District Commanders.

NOTE: If you already own an All State cover for this position you will be offered a special insignia, a Gold Star and year pin, to place on your current cover instead of receiving a new cover. This will allow the next Commander in line to receive his/her first cover. As can be deduced from above the Department will only purchase four (4) caps and unlimited Gold Stars.



VFW Department of South Dakota Membership Campaign

2018 - 2019



The membership campaign will start on July 1, 2018 and end on **June 12, 2019**. This will allow time to process each winner for awards.

Who May Participate: Campaign is open to all VFW and Auxiliary members. Any VFW member or Auxiliary member that recruits or reinstates one of more VFW members for the South Dakota VFW will receive a beautiful distinctive South Dakota "Providing Top Cover" Recruiter pin. A recruiter must recruit members only for South Dakota.

Recruiting from Another State: If a recruiter should by chance entice a member from another state to transfer his or her membership to a SD VFW Post, this member will be considered the same as a newly recruited member and the recruiter will be eligible for a South Dakota "Recruiter" pin.

How Many Pins May I Receive: A recruiter may only receive 1 (ONE) South Dakota "Providing Top Cover" pin, regardless of how many new members that he or she may recruit. It is common knowledge that the monthly National membership roster will have errors and the recruiters might not get credit for a new member and be included on the roster. This is often not the fault of the Post QM that sent the information into National. Therefore, each Post QM is asked to keep in close contact with the State Membership Chairman who will be receiving the National roster on a weekly/monthly basis. In case a recruiter's name does not appear on the National roster, a statement by the Post QM that a member did in fact recruit or reinstate a new member will be accepted so that a South Dakota "Providing Top Cover" pin may be awarded to that recruiter.

RECRUITING INCENTIVES

TOP RECRUITER

The Member who signs up the most New, New Life or Reinstated Members will receive a \$200 gift certificate from the VFW store. The Top Recruiter will not be eligible for the incentives below.

District Membership Captains that achieve 100% or greater in district membership will receive a membership "Captain" pin and \$50. The District will also receive \$50 to be used for membership roundups/activities the following year.

Post Membership Captains that achieve **100%** or greater in post membership will receive a membership "Captain" pin.

State Headquarters will use information from the National Monthly Recruiter Report. <u>Cut off date May 31, 2019.</u>

Recruit 5 new reinstated members and receive \$25

Recruit 10 new or reinstated members and receive \$50

Recruit 15 or more new or reinstated member and receive \$75

Recruit 5 new reinstated members and receive \$50

Recruit 10 new or reinstated members and receive \$75

Recruit 20 or more new or reinstated members and receive \$200 plus \$25 for additional over 20 members.

LEGACY Life Members (Post)

Recruit 2 new Legacy or increased Legacy level members and receive \$50

Recruit 5 new Legacy or increased Legacy level members and receive \$100

Recruit 10 new Legacy or increased Legacy level members and receive \$200

Recruit 15 new Legacy or increased Legacy level members and receive \$300

Recruit 20 new Legacy or increased Legacy level members and receive \$300 plus \$50 for additional over 20 members

100% Plus One Pin for District/Post Commanders and Quartermasters



All District/Post Commander and Quartermasters who reach 100% plus one in membership by June 10 will be awarded the "Q" pin award.


The award will be presented by the State Commander or be a delegated representative of the Department as soon as the District or Post Quota has been reached or at another appropriate time.

Post 100% Plus One Award



Contest is for Posts who reach 100% plus one in membership that was assigned to them by the membership committee for the 2019 membership year. Cut-off date for this contest will be based on the members reported for each Post to National Headquarters Direct Dues Department on May 31. The top 3 posts (100% + N) will receive a 2019 Membership Post Quota Buster Plaque. All other posts that reach 100% and 100%+ will receive certificates.

First Post Quota Buster Award for each Membership Category



A membership Post quota buster award plaque will be presented to the first two Posts that reach 100% plus one in the Department. Cut-off date for this contest will be based on the members reported for each Post to National Headquarters Direct Dues Department on May 31.

Program Contests for 2018 – 2019

Loyalty Day Certificates

All entries will receive certificates.

Publications Contest

A plaque will be given to the first-place winners in two categories and certificates to all entries.

Hospital Awards Contest

A plaque will be given to the first-place winners in all six membership categories and certificates to all entries.

Safety Awards Contest

A plaque will be given to the first-place winners in all six membership categories and certificates to all entries.

Community Service and Program Books

A plaque will be given to the first place winner and certificates to all other entries.

Poppy Awards

A plaque will be given to the District and Post with the largest percentage increase in Buddy Poppy purchases and must have purchased minimum prior year.

A plaque will be given to the District and Post with the largest number increase in Buddy Poppy purchases and must purchase minimum prior year.

(Minimum is 5 poppies for each 12 members)
