DEPARTMENT COMMANDER JANUARY GENERAL ORDERS

2023 has arrived. Hopefully, each of you had a great Christmas and are looking forward to the New Year. The winter has been extremely challenging. Please stay connected with our less fortunate and homebound Veterans and families with a phone call or visit.

Our Council of Administration/Legislative Conference is scheduled for February 5 & 6, 2023 at the Moose Lodge in Ft. Pierre. Register as soon as possible. Rooms are blocked off at the Ramkota in Pierre. Registration Form is included in these General Orders.

The Audit, Budget, Legislative & Bylaws Committees are scheduled to meet Sunday morning, followed by the COA Conference in the afternoon. All Committee members are encouraged to attend. If you have input for any of these Committees or the COA contact the appointed members or Department Headquarters. Monday's schedule includes a luncheon and the introduction of each District Voice of Democracy, Patriots Pen and Teachers Award winners and the announcement of the State winners in each category. Preceding this ceremony, the students will have the opportunity to visit the State Capital. The Legislative Mixer will be held Monday evening.

The Commander-in-Chief has asked each Post to recruit at least one new member this year. A number of Posts in the Department have not reached that goal. Continue your Recruiting efforts.

Retention must be at the Top of our calendar for the next few months. Following is an overview of each District's remaining Unpaid Total and of that number the Total Expired Members including the Total Number that will Expire on or before January 31, 2023. District 1 – Total Unpaid (185) / Expired/Expiring 1/31 (77); District 4 – Total Unpaid (110) / Expired/Expiring 1/31 (44); District 6 – Total Unpaid (178) / Expired/Expiring 1/31 (38); District 7 – Total Unpaid (48) / Expired/Expiring 1/31 (27); District 10 – Total Unpaid (153) / Expired/Expiring 1/31 (94). The numbers tell us that as a Department we have (280) members who have Expired or will Expire on January 31. Our Post Recruiting/Retention Membership Teams should be making every effort to Retain these Comrades. We must take care of these Veterans. Let no one behind.

Our Department currently stands at 93.5%. Our next goal is 94% by January 31st. As of these General Orders we have twelve Quota Buster Posts (Lemmon-113.04%, Marty-108.33%, Flandreau-107.69%, Parkston-105.95%, Brandon-105.10%, Chamberlain-103.57%, Quinn-103.03%, Newell-102.22%, Gettysburg-101.72%, Burke-101.26%, Wagner-100.79% & Custer-100.71%) and three Posts who have reached their Quota (Belle Fourche, Faith & Huron). Every Post should strive to join this group.

Last Chance for Congress to Support Veterans this Year: The Senate must pass this critically needed legislation before the end of the 117th Congress. Contact your senators today and tell them to pass <u>H.R.</u> <u>1361</u>, *Advancing Uniform Transportation Opportunities for Veterans Act*, known as the *AUTO for Veterans Act*; <u>H.R. 1836</u>, *Guard and Reserve GI Bill Parity Act of 2021*; <u>H.R. 6411</u>, *Support The Resiliency of Our Nation's Great Veterans Act of 2022*, known as the *STRONG Veterans Act of 2022*; and <u>S. 2513</u>, *Brian Neuman Department of Veterans Affairs Clothing Allowance Improvement Act of 2021*.

The VFW urges the Senate to finish the job on veteran's legislation this year. Our veterans cannot afford to wait any longer for these benefits.

Background: The Senate must pass this critically needed legislation before the end of the 117th Congress. The House has done its part, and now the Senate must finish the job.

H.R. 1361, Advancing Uniform Transportation Opportunities for Veterans Act, also known as the AUTO for Veterans Act, would ease the financial burden of the most severely disabled veterans.

H.R. 1836, *Guard and Reserve GI Bill Parity Act of 2021*, is a long overdue resolution to the countless members of the Guard and Reserve who serve on active duty orders for periods of time shorter than the ninety-day requirement to receive GI Bill eligibility.

H.R. 6411, Support The Resiliency of Our Nation's Great Veterans Act of 2022, or the STRONG Veterans Act of 2022, would authorize pilot programs, expanded mental health care, studies and research, outreach to veterans regarding mental health resources, and update training provided by VA for their workforce and Veterans Crisis Line staff.

<u>S. 2513</u>, Brian Neuman Department of Veterans Affairs Clothing Allowance Improvement Act of 2021, would allow for the commonsense renewal of this allowance, easing the administrative burden on both VA and veterans in need.

Greetings Comrades,

I hope you all had a good holiday and were able to spend time with family.

I would like to start out with thanking Cody for all he has done for the VFW and Veterans in the state. I would also like to thank him for supporting me for the position of Department Service Officer and wish him well in his future endeavors.

Let me give you a little background on myself. I started my military career on active duty with the Marine Corps. After which, I transitioned into the Marine Corps Reserve in Omaha while attending college. I then had a break in service and returned later by joining the Army Reserve. With my retirement in May, it will be a combined service of 29 years. Currently I work for the South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs as a Field Veterans Service Officer. My area covers the southeast portion of the state. I look forward to serving as the Department Service Officer and hope to meet as many of you as I can. Each month I will be putting out things that we are seeing in claims along with pointers to assist in the process. If there are any questions outside of that, I can always be reached at my e-mail or phone.

PACT Act claims are now being processed. Some of the questions we are getting are, how long will it take and what will the back date be? Let Veterans know that even though the VA has hired additional staff, they have already received over 175,000 claims. Please remember, if you have a terminally ill Veteran, note that on the claim as they will be pushed to the front of the line. Claims that are submitted within the first year and approved will be back dated to the date that the PACT Act was signed.
